## **Faith Formation Programs**

Empowering God's Children is a program developed by VIRTUS online to be used in Catholic Schools and parishes to assist children and young people in recognizing their dignity and to advocate for their own physical and emotional protection. It is of vital importance that EVERY child and youth be given the opportunity to take part in this critical element of our Safe Environment Program because of the practical life skills it teaches young people. It will not be mandatory, and parental consent (form included) is required.

Elementary Christian Formation-(*PreK-4yrs thru 5<sup>th</sup> grade*) Classes are offered on Sunday mornings from 9:45-11:00am. This year we will continue to use the curriculum of *Pflaum Gospel Weeklies* which offers a lectionary-based approach to learning about our faith. The program introduces the weekly Gospel reading, so it is a great way to know what your child is learning in class. This also provides a foundation that enables your child to understand and engage in the Gospel reading during mass. We will offer other seasonal events which will allow your family to participate together in prayer, instruction, and fellowship. A schedule of classes, which includes dates for Fun with Faith days, is included in this packet.

Sacramental Preparation-students in second grade, and older, are invited to prepare for the Sacraments of Reconciliation and First Eucharist. Sacramental Preparation includes a Parent Orientation as well as two classes and 1 retreat prior to receiving each sacrament. Parents will be notified of the dates when Parent Orientation and Sacramental Preparation will begin. Parents **are expected** to attend sacramental parent orientation, or make alternative arrangements, prior to children beginning sacramental preparation classes.

<u>Children's Liturgy of the Word-will</u> be offered during the Sunday masses during October –May. Children 4yrs through second grade are invited to attend. During CLOW, children will engage in prayer and will hear the weekly reading and the Gospel presented at their developmental level. Availability of this program is dependent on having enough volunteers to support the program.

Vacation Bible School-a week of songs, crafts and activities based on Bible related themes is offered during the summer. This is available to families with children Kindergarten through 5<sup>th</sup> grade. Middle and High School students are welcome, and encouraged, to participate as volunteers. Availability of this program is dependent on having enough volunteers to support the program.

**MS/HS Formation:** Each week both Middle and High School students will gather for formation and fellowship. Middle school (6<sup>th</sup> & 7<sup>th</sup>) and our JR/SR group gather in the school while 8<sup>th</sup>-10th graders will remain in the Worship Space. There is a specific "Pick Up Protocol". Please review the enclosed instructions and follow accordingly. Thank you! Please note that Celebrate Youth Masses are typically held on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Sunday of each month during the regularly scheduled 11:15a Mass. This is an "official class", hosted by individual grades, and students are expected to attend! There IS Youth Group on those evenings as well!

There is an optional meal plan for those interested in participating in the meal offered during the hour prior to regular formation sessions. We have a one-time \$30 fee, or a recommended \$5 fee per meal, for students interested in participating in this social time. *Please be sure to check the box if your child is interested in participating in the meal option each week*.

<u>Middle School Youth Group</u> – grades 6-7 –Our middle school students use the Pflaum Gospel Weekly, <u>Vision</u>, which offers a lectionary-based approach to learning about our faith, as the basis for their classroom breakouts. Additional seasonal information/activities may be included, or replace specific weeks, depending on appropriate timing.

High School Youth Group – grades 8-12 – The High School program follows a 4-year cycle using the 4 pillars of the Catechism: Creed, Sacraments, Morality and Prayer and Discipleship (Prayer is woven into all 4 years and is not a separate yearly theme). Our theme for the 2024-2025 year is "Creed". Students will meet in large group sessions with informal small group breakouts. Our 11<sup>th</sup>/12<sup>th</sup> grade students will spend time in more in-depth conversation on the theme for the year and at times assist with the presentation at large. Additional seasonal information/activities may be included, or replace specific weeks, depending on appropriate timing. If you have a tenth grader preparing for Confirmation, participation in HS Youth Group and Confirmation preparation is a requirement. **Confirmation** – grade 10 – All tenth graders preparing for Confirmation will be expected to attend High School Youth group, a Confirmation kickoff day-long retreat (Sept 16), a Confirmation Weekend retreat (January 12-14) and a final retreat (scheduled after celebrating the Sacrament) geared specifically toward Confirmation preparation.

CATECHIST ORIENTATION and PICNIC: September 8, from 1:00p-4:00p

VIRTUS TRAINING: All adults (18+) must complete VIRTUS training to work with youth. These trainings can be registered for at <u>www.virtusonline.org</u>. You must register for a session through this link. Contact the Christian Formation Staff with any questions or concerns.
