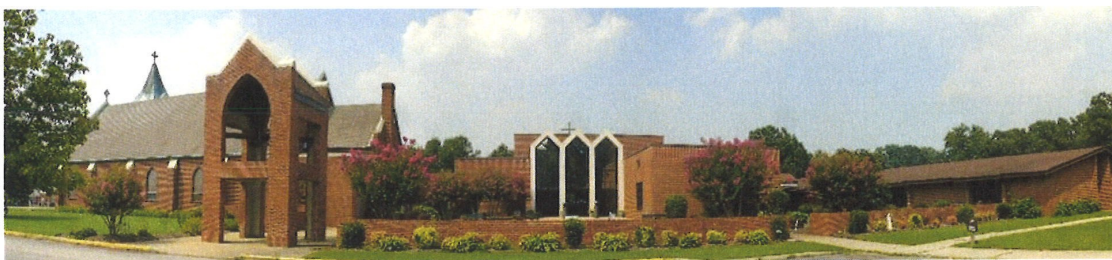

In the *Walking Our Pilgrim Trail* campaign, this means:

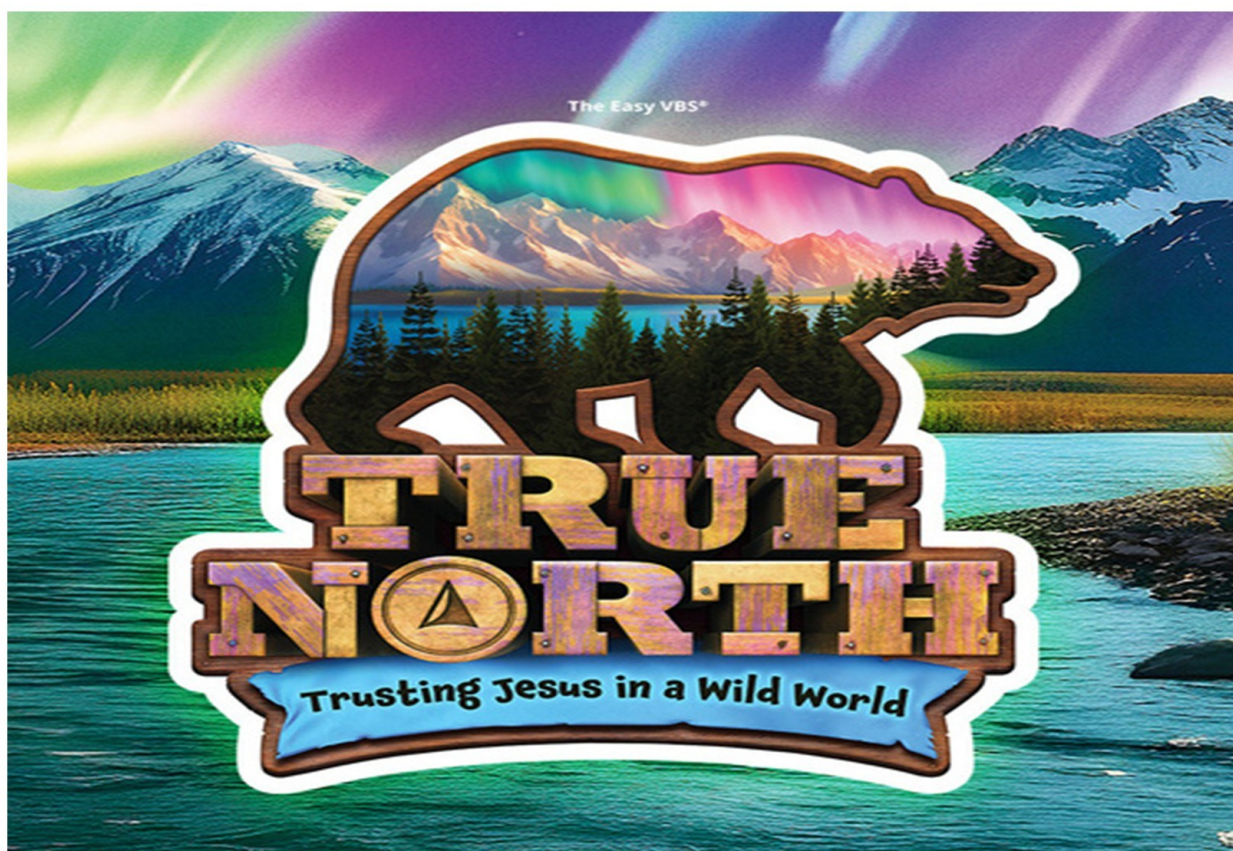
- 1) Bringing the Tabernacle into our worship space

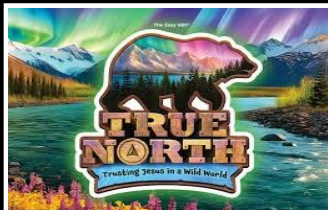

CONFIRMATION UPDATES

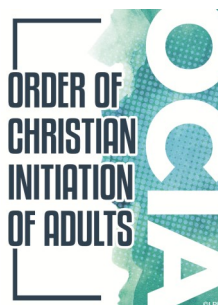

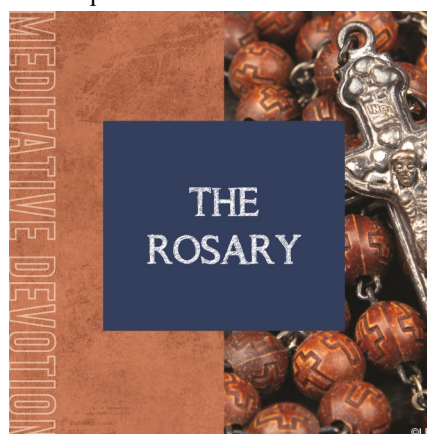
