St. Ann Centennial Celebration

Procession Route & Timing

- The route is approximately 1 mile long.
- It will take about 1 to 1.5 hours to complete due to three planned prayer/adoration stops:
 - Stop #1: Intersection of Beechwood and Harrowgate
 - Stop #2: Fire Station #21
 - Stop #3: Original church entrance to Condon Hall
 - Stop #4: Concludes with Benediction in the Worship Space

What to Wear

- Wear comfortable walking shoes and light, casual clothing
- If possible, wear your St. Ann Centennial shirt to show community spirit!

What to Bring

- A water bottle, hat, and sunblock
- Rain gear, if showers are forecast the event will proceed rain or shine

Road Closures & Safety Notice

- Chesterfield County Police will block parts of Beechwood Avenue and Harrowgate Road starting at 9:00 a.m.
- Please avoid these areas if you're not participating in the procession

P Shuttle & Parking Information

Shuttle Service (7:30 - 8:30 a.m.):

- Volunteers will shuttle participants from **St. Ann parking areas** to the cemetery
- Early drop-offs are okay, but please don't wait until the last minute

Personal Drop-Offs:

- Participants may be dropped off at the cemetery
- Drivers must depart promptly
- All drop-offs must be completed by 8:30 a.m.

On-Site Organization:

Volunteers will organize parishioners in proper order before the procession begins

Parking Assistance:

- Knights and volunteers will direct traffic in the front and back lots
- Overflow parking available:
 - Field behind St. Ann's back parking lot
 - o Limited spaces at **The Heights Baptist Church** (nearest the traffic light)
- Please follow all instructions from transportation and parking volunteers

% Health & Safety Guidelines

- A few parishioners with **medical training** will assist during the procession
- Do not participate if you are unwell or unable to walk the full route

Medical Assistance:

- For minor issues:
 - Move to the back of the procession
 - o A **trailing vehicle** will be available (limited seating)
