"SPRING CLEANING YARD SALE" June 7 from 8a-1p in the church parking lot: After some low participation in our Spring and Fall events last year, and some evaluation conversation with some of my favorite vendors, we have decided to try something different this year. Here is what it will look like:

1. **Spring will be a YARD SALE event only-** "SPRING CLEANING YARD SALE". Some concerns were voiced over the combining of Yard Sale and Vendors as some shoppers would be looking for "yard sale" prices on "vendor" items resulting in decreased vendor sales. We want everyone to be successful, so we are going to try separate events this year. Currently, each slot consists of 2 parking spaces and will remain at the \$35 fee. Should you need more space, you can reserve 2 more spaces for an additional \$15. Limited tables (\$10) and tents (\$25) will be available for rent. Vendor reservations are not accepted at this event. Parish donations for the YOUTH GROUP portion of the yard sale will be accepted June 2-6 during regular business hours or contact Elise to set up a time for drop off. Thank You 😊

2. Our **"Christmas in November"** event, on November 8, will be a "Vendors Only" event. It is our intention to make it a bigger event with Food Trucks, Music and other Festival type events. Because it will be a bigger event our fees will increase a bit to try and offset the cost of the extras. Each Slot (1 parking space) will be \$35, and you can reserve 2 spots for \$50. Limited tables (\$10) and tents (\$25) will be available for rent. We will continue to promise our "1 only" of specific vendors (Scentsy, Tupperware, LuLaRoe, etc.) so first come, first serve. This "1 only" does NOT apply to crafters and food vendors. Yard Sale reservations will not be accepted for this event.
