If your email has changed, or you are new to St. Ann, please contact the office to ensure that you receive your forms. These forms can be filled out online but must be saved under a different name and either printed out and returned OR sent back to us electronically. Fees are now expected to be submitted with forms. Fees are now due for any forms submitted during our early registration. In your registration email, you will receive Intro letter and regular registration forms, calendars for regular formation, and sacramental registration forms and calendars. If you have a student preparing for a Sacrament, please submit that registration at the same time as your regular registration AND submit a separate payment for Sacraments. This assists in allocating the proper funds to the proper account. Fees can be made via WE SHARE once that link is activated. Those fees incur a small processing fee because of the added expense for using a credit card. Please note: If your family needs a partial or full scholarship, please let us know.
