### Spring Baptisms are coming up!

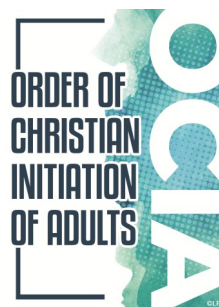
