**MORE CENTENNIAL NEWS!** We are getting ready for the St. Ann Feast Day celebrations on Saturday, July 26. If you were at Masses this past weekend, you heard about the need for volunteers. We'll need folks in the following areas for the Eucharistic procession from the cemetery to the church:

- Vans to transport folks from the church parking lot to the cemetery for the procession. There will be no parking at the cemetery. Approximately 7:30-9:00am. (We have not settled on whether we'll use parishioners to transport or if we'll rent transportation, but we want to get an idea of who could help.)
- Volunteers to help carry the canopy, the statue of St. Ann (on a small platform with handles), the banner, etc. No one will need to carry anything the entire way; the plan is to switch out during stops in the procession.

Altar servers (and perhaps others) to carry the processional cross and candles. Again, we'll
switch out.

It's our intention to provide some transportation for those who cannot walk the 1-mile procession route. If you would like to take advantage of this transportation, please sign up.

With continued growth, an expansion project doubled the space of the garage where the current pantry is located, and we now serve over 900 people each month.
