

ELEMENTARY CHRISTIAN FORMATION May 5, 2024

Congratulations to our 5th Graders who are preparing to move to Middle School! What an exciting time!

This Sunday's Gospel: John 15:9-17 In this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus tells his disciples, "As the Father loves me, so I also love you." The Gospel is taken from a long talk Jesus had with his disciples at the Last Supper. He calls them to live on in his love and gives them a great commandment: "Love one another as I love you."

Seeds (Preschool): This week, your child will learn that love brings us together. Remember that your child learns about love from experiencing the caring and loving actions he or she receives at home. He or she will also learn to pray the Rosary. Practice the prayer at home. Ask your child to share the stand-up story cards and to tell the family what he or she remembers about story that goes with the pictures. The message of the story is that love brings us together.


Promise (Grades K-1): Your child will learn about Jesus' one rule—love. Make sure your child understands that Jesus is always with us to help us grow into people who love other people the way he loves us. Pray that your family will always love others as Jesus loves your family.


Good News (Grades 2-3): Your child's class will talk about Jesus' new Law of Love. Talk about the ways you show love in your family. Talk as well about the ways your family shows love to those outside of it. Make sure your child sees our call to love as their lifelong mission. Pray the Prayer of Mission from the lesson as a family this week.

Venture (Grades 4-6): In class, your son or daughter will learn that they need to put Jesus' commandment to "love one another" into action. He or she will also explore the Church's devotion to Mary and how her life is revealed in the Bible. Have your child show you the Living the Gospel activity. How did your child do putting the timeline in order? Discuss the Summer Prayer for the Holy Spirit. How will the Holy Spirit guide your youngster this summer? Finally, have your son or daughter tell you about Saint Mother Theodore Guérin, founder of the Sisters of the Providence of Saint-Mary-of-the-Woods.

Our 5th Graders will be hosting Celebrate Youth Mass at the 11:15a Mass on Sunday. A separate email was sent just to 5th grade parents regarding roles the students signed up for and copies of the readings so that students can practice prior to Mass time. Students will meet at the church at 10:30 to practice and prepare so do NOT plan to get them from their classrooms. If your family will NOT be at Mass on May 5th, please make sure to let us know so that i can make alternative arrangements.

Pray Together: Each night before bed, say the following Holy Spirit prayer together: Come Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful and kindle in them the fire of your love. Send forth your Sprit, O Lord, and our hearts shall be created. And you shall renew the face of the world. Amen.
